Workshop 32JP Assignment

Grade: Elementary grade 4,5, & 6

Scope and Sequences : Art and Literacy

Project-Based Learning : Create a book

Objectives : Increase students' creativity and self-confidence, tell story to the class, works with other students to write their stories in a book, and communicate their opinion.

Activity :

- 1) The teacher reads loudly a story about *Bawang Merah Bawang Putih* in front of the students.
- 2) The teacher asks what moral message can be taken from the story.
- 3) Invite the students interactively to tell their opinion by speak with good English structure and make sure all the students are speaking up their feelings and minds.
- 4) The teacher asks students about books, e.g., have you ever read a book, what book have you read, what kind of book do you like.
- 5) Shows students one of teacher's favorite book and a book that teacher's self-written book with a holiday theme.
- 6) Tells to the students that they also can create a book, they can be an author of the book.
- 7) Asks the students to write their story in a piece of paper. The contents of the story are activities during the holiday, who they spend the holiday with, how they feel during the holiday, and what are their plans for the next holiday.

- 8) Remind students to separate the paper for writing the story and for biodata at the bottom of the paper.
- 9) Asks the students if there is any difficulties related to the story they wrote.
- 10) The teacher assists the students when they write they story, make sure that they put their thoughts into words and write with their feelings.
- 11) Discuss with the students about the title of the book that they have created.
- 12) Asks the students feeling after finish their story.
- 13) Motivates students that they could make more books if they are more diligent in writing and they can become famous-great writers.
- 14) The teacher will display the book in the library of RPTRA Edelweiss, so the students can read the book in turn.
