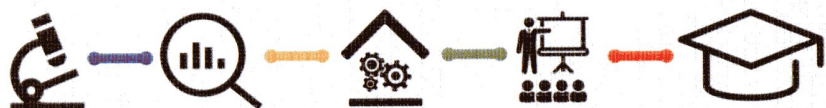


We also would like to apologize if our efforts and our services still unfulfilled your satisfaction. We sincerely hope that every participant will enjoy this congress.
