Editor and Reviewer comments:

This is a major revision requiring additional data and extensive rewriting of the manuscript. Authors are urged to address the criticisms raised by the reviewers and the Editor to the fullest, as a partial revision will prompt rejection. Please, highlight the alterations and explain all changes in the cover letter.

EDITOR IN CHIEF

1. The study is preliminary and lack of novelties. Authors must improve the presentation and discussion of results, highlighting the novel findings in view of the vast literature.
2. the manuscript should be re-arranged as a short communication in which Figures 1,2 and 3 and Table 1 are moved as Supplementary. The characterization should be described more concisely.
3. Additional data are required to support the claim, and particularly PGE2, MPO and IL-8 should be assayed.
4. Histology micrographs: staining quality should be improved, include scale bar and indicate magnification in legend; include inset at higher magnification for areas of interest.
5. Legends must be self-explanatory with brief description of the experimental conditions and outcome.
6. Avoid overinterpretation and speculation.
7. where applicable, refer to relevant articles published in JTCM dealing with ginger and inflammatory diseases.
8. Graphical abstract must be updated with new data.
9. manuscript requires a professional copyediting to fix grammar/syntax errors.

Reviewer #1: 1- In first place, I recommend that this article should be proofread by an English proofreader, due to the existence of several spelling error.

- 2- I suggest you replace the words Sacrificed for euthanasied.
- 3- Introduction:
 - a) The writing of the introduction is very brief. Your work focuses on the enzyme lipoxigenase but the authors writes little about it, as well as other important points that the authors focuses on results and discussion. Besides, it missed a describe about the importance of this Aromatic ginger (Jencur) and why the authors choose it.
 - b) Besides, I suggest investigate more the literature and specify more articles. Example: In line 51-52 the authors comment "several studies" but just have 2 references at the and of sentence.
- 4- Material and methods:
 - a) The author does not specify the number of animals and neither the experimental groups that has been used and analyzed at this study. How many animals have been used? How many experimental groups have been used at this study?
 - b) On the topic 2.10 the author does not explain the tissue used for collecting. However, it is possible to notice that more than one tissue were being used, at the figure number 5.
 - c) The writing of the text in general is a lot confused, I would suggest you rewrite it more clearly.
- 5- In the topic of results and discussion:
 - a) The author does not explain how the values are being expressed in the figures. As it is possible to see at the figure 4, figure 6, table 2.
