The result was $r_{o}$ was higher than $r_{\text {table }}\left(r_{0}>r_{\text {table }}=0,418>0,325\right)$ so, Ho was rejected and Hi was accepted. It can be concluded that there is a relationship between the students' habits of listening to English songs and the listening comprehension

The writer analyzed $t_{\text {test }}$ significance by using $t_{\text {test. }}$. The result was $t_{o}$ is higher than $\mathrm{t}_{\text {table }}\left(\mathrm{t}_{0}>\mathrm{t}_{\text {table }}=2,67>1,69\right)$ so, Ho was rejected and Hi was accepted. It can be concluded that there is a significant relationship between the students' habits of listening to English songs and the listening comprehension. The writer hopes the result of the research is useful for the writer and the English teacher.

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## CHAPTER I

## INTRODUCTION

## A. Background of The Research Problem

Based on the writer's experience in SMPN 52 Jakarta, teaching listening comprehension was a seemingly unsatisfied result. Some of the English teachers didn't pay attention to the listening ability. They just used the tape recorder for teaching listening to students. They didn't use various kinds of teaching techniques. Therefore, the students quickly got bored and didn't have any motivation to learn listening. The result was a bad score for their listening tests because they found some difficulties answering the question test.

Related to this, teachers need to find new ways of the teaching-learning process. The teacher can use various techniques to teach listening, such as watching English movies and listening to English songs.

Nowadays, singing a song and listening to music becomes one of the habit categories. Butler (1995:61)in Zara 2013:2)) believed that habits are automatic routine behavior that is repeated regularly without thinking. In other words, habit makes someone mastering English consistently.

The song will be the easiest way to help students develop their listening abilities. By listening to English songs, students can be more interested in learning listening due to simple and repetitive ways. Furthermore, students can listen to a song related to technology advances, especially in English songs, anywhere, and anytime.

It is supported by previous researchers who have conducted research related to this topic. Among them, Nurkholis Solehudin (2018:63) found that students who often listened to English songs were more accessible in improving listening skills. Niki Brillian (2016:51) also found that the listening frequency to English songs help students improve their listening achievement.

Referring to the explanation above, the writer inspires to do the research of the relationship between the students' habits of listening to English songs and the listening comprehension of eighth grade students of SMPN 52 Jakarta on the first semester in the 2020/2021 academic year.
