Review 1:

need more details about duration and volume of smoking in smokers (could be measured in pack- years; 1 pack per day x 20 years= 20 pack years; 2 packs per day x 20 years=40 pack years).

more detailed discussion on how passive smoking was assessed with some estimate on duration (years) of exposure.

Review 2:

The author investigated the association between cigarette smoking patterns and severity of COVID-19: Findings from a study in 15 private Hospitals in Indonesia. The aim of this research is not well defined, and author should include in the abstract and introduction part. Result sections need to re-write with way that is more scientific; should present the numerical values and statistical analysis data, as well as little explanation of results. The author should cite some latest review articles on smoking and COVID-19 such as PMID: 35501222 and PMID: 32916821. The language in the manuscript is not adequate for publication. Incomplete sentences and grammatical errors need attention.

Review 3:

This is a manuscript reporting the impact of smoking status COVID-19 patient severity. The idea behind this study is valuable and important. But the following concerns need to be highlighted.

The author explained in the research method: "The severity of COVID-19 was defined based on The Guidelines on The Prevention and Control of COVID-19 (5th Edition) issued by the Indonesian Ministry of Health." However, there is no severity data in the paper, which only refers to the cases received the treatment in the outpatient department,

inpatient department and ICU, so the study data is not rigorous.

Further discussion of research findings COVID-19 severity is not associated with smoking, but with the amount of smoking

Further discussion why: this report :The current smoking rate of COVID-19 patients (17.1%) was lower than the overall smoking rate of the population (33%) in Indonesia.

Please read references more extensively about the following statement. Because there have been studies reporting a link between smoking and the severity of COVID-19.

"But this research was one of the first to investigate how smoking habits affect the severity of COVID-19 in Hospitalized patients, particularly in Indonesia."

The limitation of the design of this study is that all the cases were from private hospitals, and the severity of the patients could not be determined by the diagnosis of doctors. It cannot be ruled out that economically advantaged patients who may not be eligible for hospitalization were hospitalized, while economically disadvantaged patients with more severe conditions were not hospitalized, which may bias the results.

Table 1 needs to be changed into a three-line Table

Line 1: Intensive Care Unit+Inpatient+ medical city =500, which is not consistent with sample 490 in this study

Review 4:

An interesting study on the association between smoking and COVID-19 severity. There is substantial information within the peer reviewed literature on this topic, however regional evidence from Indonesia is lacking and hence this report is novel.

I have the below following major comments:

The manuscript aims to assess the association between smoking and COVID-19 severity, however "severity" in this context is defined as either being an "outpatient", hospitalized" or "ICU (Hence three categories of severity).

- 1) The methods section of the abstract should note the month and year of the study to provide context (April to August 2020). Please also define in the abstract how you defined "severity" of COVID 19.
- 2) The results section of the abstract is missing information. Please add detailed numerical results in the text related to the number of cigarettes smoked.
- 3) The conclusions of the abstract do not stem from the results.
- 4) The methods section needs a better presentation on how you define severity. In this case, it seems like "Severity of COVID-19 was defined as either hospitalization and ICU admission in comparison to those with COVID-19 in the outpatient setting". However above in line 56 the authors state "The respondents who participated in this study were patients who had been hospitalized" please clarify, how the outpatients were hospitalized.
- 5) Age is a significant confounding factor in the association between adverse outcomes of COVID-19, and these analyses are unadjusted. This should be noted in the limitations section.
- 6) Line 82 "Patients who had quit smoking in more than 5 years, 1-5 years, or <1 year had the same chances of getting severe COVID-19" This is incorrect as the authors are using causal language. Due to study design, causality can not be induced. Hence delete the wording of "chances" or "odds" and simply report ratios.
- 7) The results in the table have calculated % per line instead of % per column. Please correct. This will change all the results of the study. \
- Reduce the decimal points to 1 from 2 in both the smoking duration and the daily number of cigarettes smoked.
- 9) Please re-assess your results and then possibly rephrase lines 96-99
- 10) In line 106 the authors note "moderate and mild symptoms" this has not been predefined. Please use the definitions of the methods section.
- 11) The limitations do not include all the aspects that could have led to this difference. Please add such information to the discussion section:
- a. Critically ill COVID-19 patients have severe comorbidities that may exclude them from being admitted to a hospital or intensive care unit.
- b. Many smokers have already died of smoking-related illnesses before they reach the age of the average COVID-19 hospitalization
- c. Data is cross sectional, hence can not be presented within a causal framework
