



Thank you for revising your paper. If I may suggest, the conclusion could be further clarified:
I cite your text in italics:


- You say in your conclusion that "the majority of the tarbiyah movement is female", could you give more data on this? Do men have their own liqo, and if so, how do you compare them with women's liqo? Which are the more numerous? It would be important to assess this to know how much men depend on women's liqo?
- You cite the book *Varieties of religious authority* by Azra, van Dyck and Kaptein, 2010, for Machasin's article, but not in your introduction page 2 (Abdullah 2017 etc), while this book is, as far as I know, the first attempt to assess the changes in religious authority in Indonesia. Why so?
- The term *usroh* should come earlier on when you explain what the liqo are: it comes only page 6 while it should appear at least in page 4 when you start explaining the origins of the term liqo. People who know of usroh wonder all along whether it is indeed the usroh you are speaking of."

We plan to publish your article in our next issue (fall 2021) and to this end, we need your very last version within five-six weeks (mid-August). For this final step (and before the text is laid out), you'll be accompanied by Dr. Andrée Feillard. Therefore if you have any question of hesitation please contact her directly.




