Term of Reference Workshop on School-Based Nutrition Promotion (SBNP) Working Group 3 November 2023

Background

The Nutrition Goes to School (NGTS) Program of the SEAMEO Regional Centre for Food and Nutrition (RECFON) was launched in 2017 to improve the nutrition knowledge and practice of schoolage children at all levels in Southeast Asia. School-aged children are an important group to be targeted for nutrition promotion because good nutrition habits should be started early for them to continue on toward their adult age. As part of this effort, SEAMEO RECFON initiated the establishment of the Indonesian School-Based Nutrition Promotion Working Group (INA-SBNP Working Group) in 2018 and the Southeast Asian School-Based Nutrition Promotion Working Group (SEA-SBNP Working Group) in March 2018. This initiative was based on the knowledge that numerous school-based nutrition interventions and programs to improve the nutrition practices and status of school children have been carried out by various institutions and organizations, either from government, non-government, or academic institutions. However, information about the success and best practices of these activities are still not well documented and mapped. Good documentation is very important for advocacy to integrate nutrition promotion activities into school activities. Evidence documentation for advocating SBNP entails collaborative efforts from institutions and individuals working on improving the nutritional status of school children and adolescents in every country. There is a need to have a group that will look after this matter.

The main purpose of the working group is to enhance the quality and mainstream the practice of SBNP as a regular activity among schools in Indonesia and other countries in the Southeast Asia region, through (1) providing relevant information on SBNP programs, activities, and policies that are currently existing in the region, (2) improve the dissemination and access of evidence-based SBNP good practices and other relevant information, (3) facilitate the increase in the number of SBNP activities and adoption of good practices among schools at all levels, and (4) establish a community of practice among school heads, teachers, and supervisors on SBNP.

In February 2022, the SEAMEO Council, via ad referendum, approved the operation and institutionalization of both the INA- and SEA- SBNP Working Group. In October 2022, the annual workshop of both INA- and SEA-SBNP Working Group membership was held back-to-back with the Regional Learning Exchange Forum on SBNP. The last annual workshop of the SBNP Working Groups successfully developed an Operation Guideline and an Action Plan period 2023-2025 for each SBNP working group. In early 2023, the membership of both INA- and SEA-SBNP Working Groups was formalized as regards the official representatives from the Ministries of Education in respective SEAMEO member countries and the institutions of working group members.

Following up on the Action Plan that was developed and agreed upon in the last workshop, SEAMEO RECFON will continue to conduct annual workshops for both the INA- and SEA-SBNP Working Groups. To streamline this workshop and also to share experiences in implementing SBNP at the Indonesian and Southeast Asian levels, this year we also plan to organize workshops for the INA and

SEA-SBNP Working Groups in one event preceded by a webinar session on SBNP that is open to the public.

Objectives

The workshop is intended to:

- 1. Share the experiences in implementing SBNP in the Indonesia level and Southeast Asia level;
- 2. Update the progress of the proposed INA- and SEA-SBNP Working Group's Three-Year Action Plan formulated during the last workshop;
- 3. Formulate the concept note of one activity for each sub-working group of both INA- and SEA-SBNP Working Groups.
