 4. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION
 5. CONCLUSION

Introduction section explains the context of the study and states the precise objective, and was presented within 3-8 paragraphs. Suggested structure of an introduction section is:

- a). Introductory paragraph (usually one or two paragraphs):
 - Give a general introduction to the topic for a broad audience
 - Narrow the focus to your particular topic
 - State your research problem and aims
- b). Literature review (usually several paragraphs):
 - Summarize the relevant literature on your topic
 - Describe the current state of the art
 - Note any gaps in the literature that your study will address
- c). Research targets (usually one paragraph):
 - Briefly describe how you will accomplish your aims
 - Give a preview and state the contribution of the work

Method section- The experimental/method section is a straightforward description of what you did in your research and how you did it, clear and detailed at every stage. A detailed method section will make your article reproducible by other researchers, allowing them to trust and build on your work.

- A detailed explanation of all methodologies, instruments, materials, procedures, measurements, and other variables used in the investigation.
- A thorough description of the data analysis and decisions for excluding some data and including others.

Results and discussion section: The manner of the results presentation should be clear and uncomplicated. This section summarizes the most relevant findings, providing statistical analysis results as appropriate and comparisons to other study findings. Figure results should not be repeated in tables. This is the section in which the author(s) should explain in detail what he/she/they uncovered throughout their investigation. It should be well-organized and in a logical order. This section should be supported by appropriate references.

We usually expect a minimum of $2n+9$ references (for original research papers) and $4n+18$ (for review/survey papers) primarily to journal articles, where n = page length of your papers (in simple words, for 8 pages, the number of references is min 25 for research papers and 50 entries for review/study papers). Citations from textbooks should be used very rarely, and citations to web pages should be avoided. All cited papers should be referenced within the text of the manuscript.
